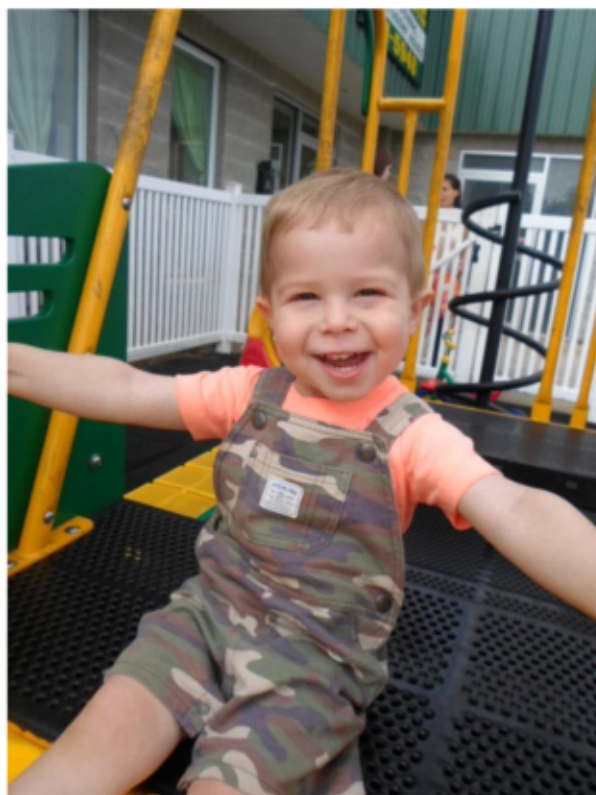

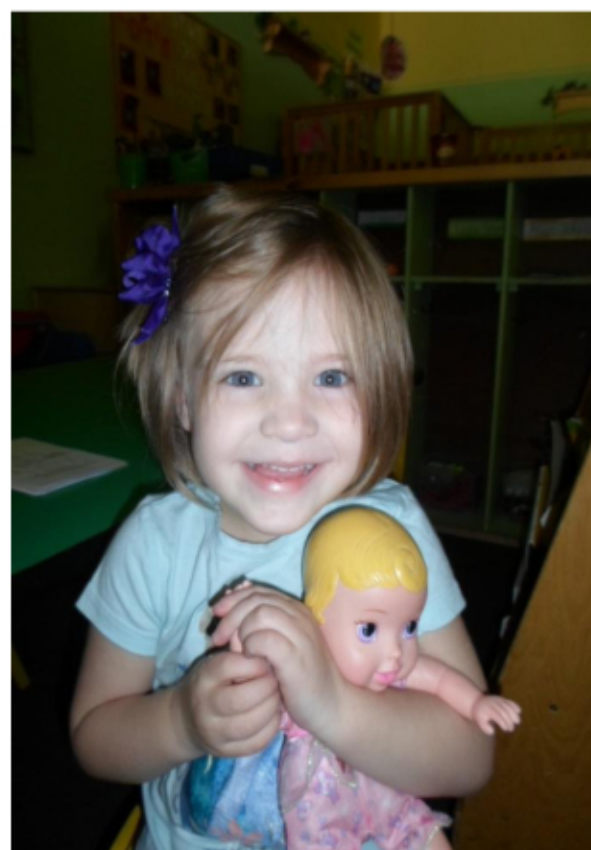


# Pre-K 3 Room News!

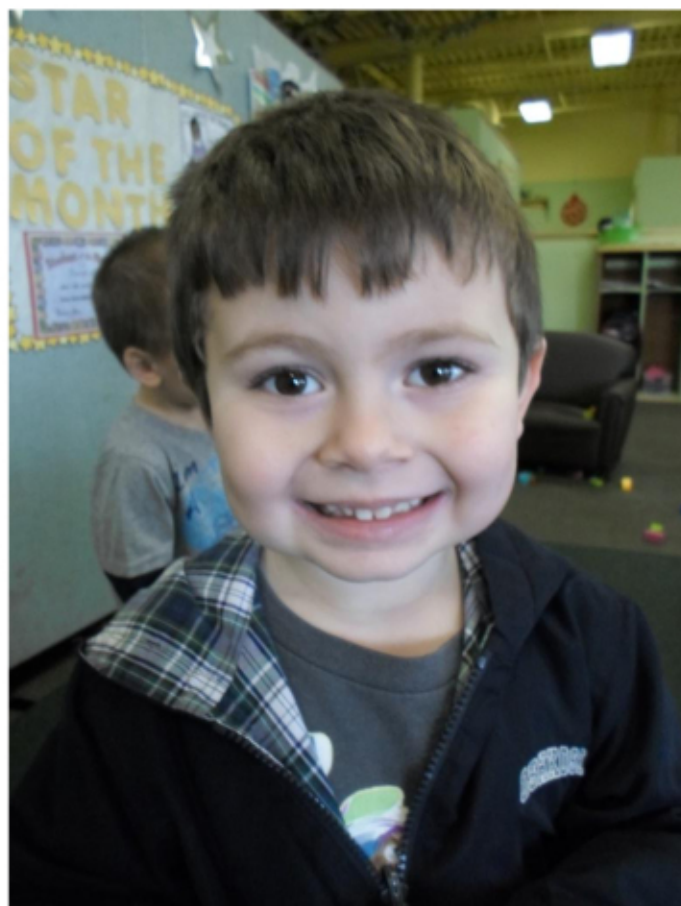
# Pre-K 4 Room News!
