Congratulations Cameron, we love you!!!

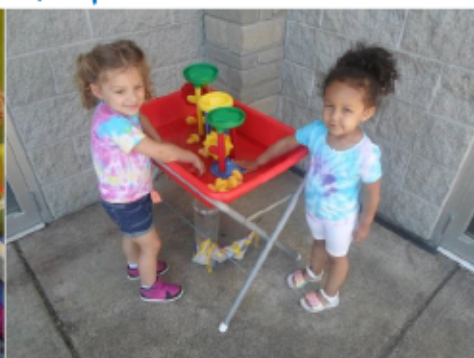
Summer Camp Room News!
