# INFANT ROOM JANUARY NEWS



## Our Monthly theme:

This January, our infant classroom will be exploring winter through gentle, sensory-based activities designed to support development, curiosity, and engagement.

### Week 1: A Winter Wonderland

### Week 2: Mitten Weather


