We will begin by celebrating Dr. Seuss' birthday, introducing the babies to colorful books, silly rhymes, and sensory play inspired by his stories.

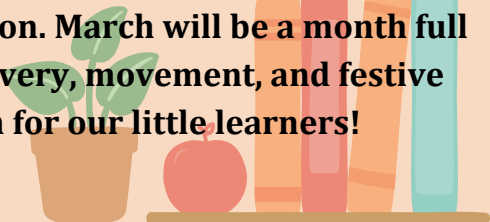
They will enjoy soft texture exploration a special green sensory bin for Green Eggs & Ham Day. As we move into the second week, we'll shift our focus to St.

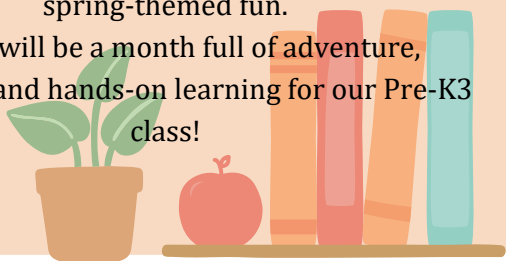
Week 3: Shamrocks & Leprechauns
