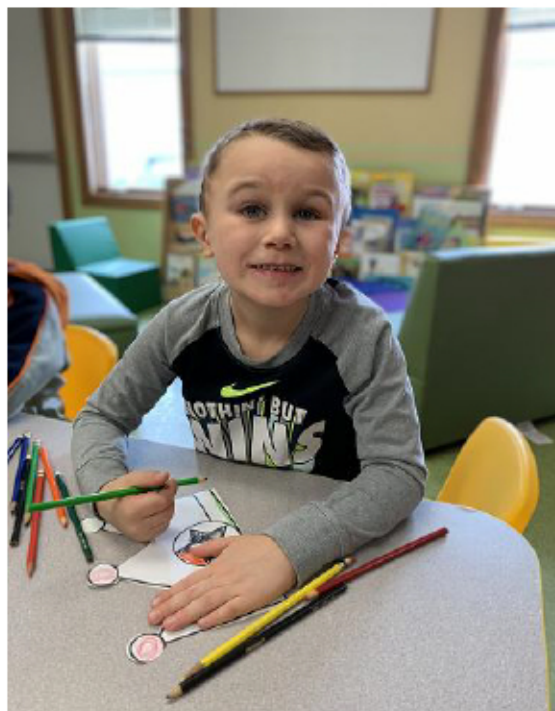

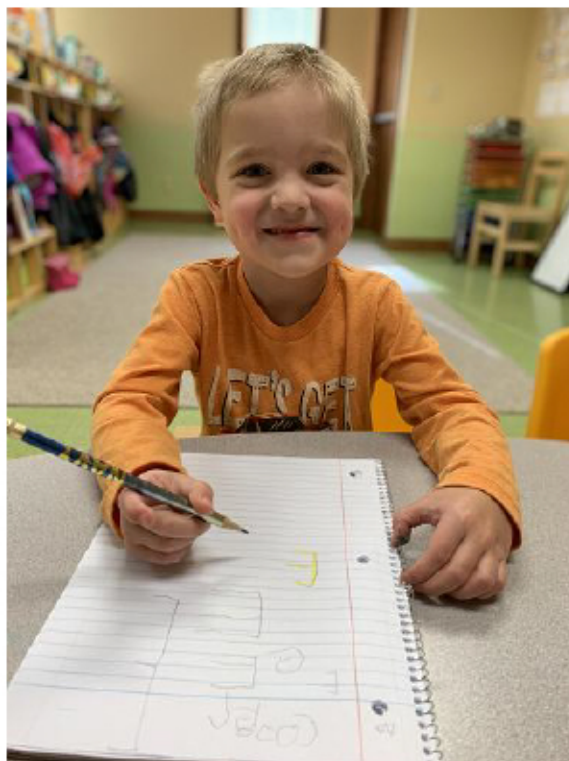
Pre-K 4 News!
