Infant News

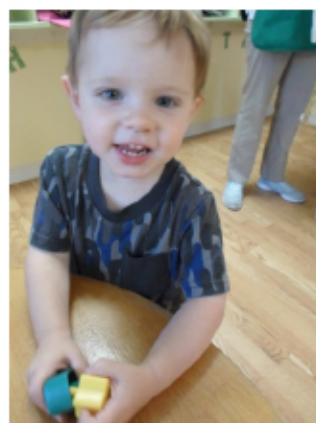
