Infant News

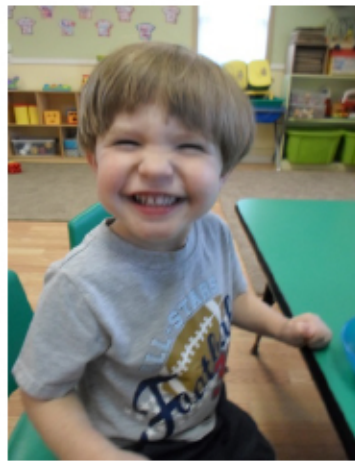
