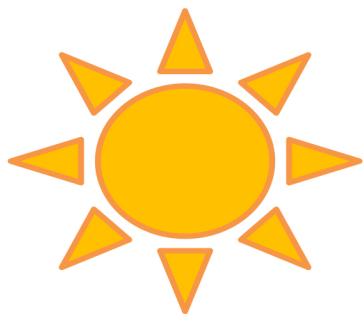


Bunny Bunch Daycare & Pre-K Newsletter
