Tuition is always due the Friday before the week of attendance. Thank you!

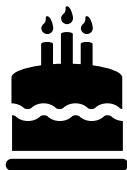

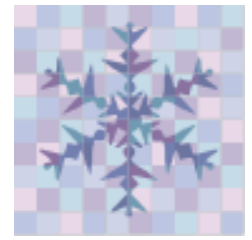
Star Students!

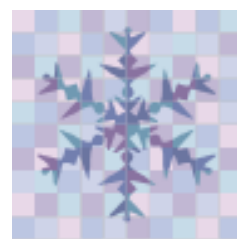
Infant Star Of The Month!

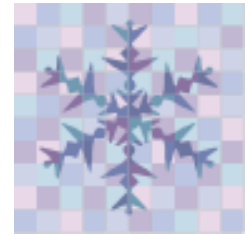


Toddler Star Of The Month!

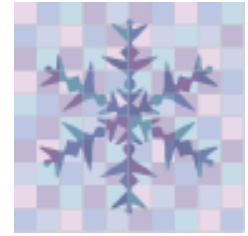
Pre-K 3 Star Of The Month!

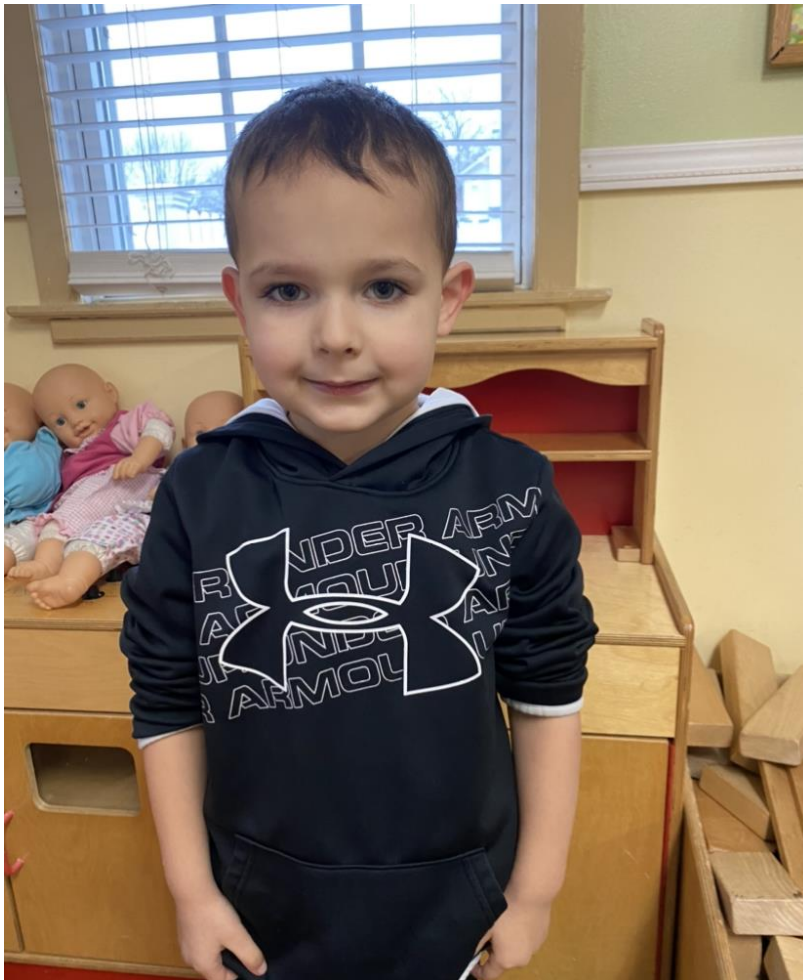
